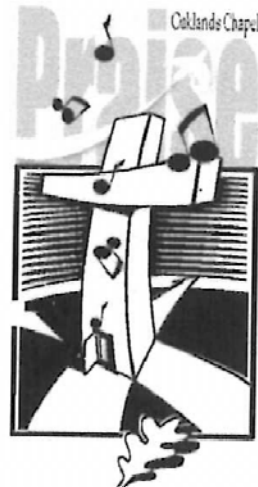

FOCUS ON MINISTRY:

QUILTS FOR MISSIONS ANGIE STEER

We meet on the second Tuesday of every month from September to June between 1 and 3 pm. The purpose for our meeting is to make children's quilts to support the Missionary efforts of the chapel.

The fabric we use has been donated by many generous people and we strive to use it to produce quilts that are both useful and beautiful. Batting is supplied by the chapel. The work is mostly done at home. At the meetings we plan the quilts together encouraging each other and making suggestions. We also sandwich the quilts at the chapel laying them out on tables and basting ready to be quilted by hand or machine.

Sadly this year we lost our friend and member, Peggy, after a long battle with cancer. We will all miss Peggy's friendly ways and willingness to help. Before she died Peggy donated the bulk of her fabric "stash" to our group. We will remember her fondly as we use her lovely fabrics in our projects this year.

It has been suggested that there are some people who would like to get involved in our efforts who work in the daytime. We are always looking for ways to include more people who want to help and so are considering having a quilting table at the monthly Dorcas meetings, starting in January. If you are interested please contact Angie Steer.

We have lots of fabric, but always need more workers. A lot of sewing skill is not required, we are always happy to teach and encourage those who have little or no quilting experience. Come and practice and learn.

Last spring as usual our work was hung in the Chapel lobby before being sent to Mexico. Even though Kelly and her team were unable to go because of the flu outbreak over 30 quilts did make it to the Orphanage for which we are very thankful.

God has blessed us with our abilities and amazes us by always supplying our needs for materials and workers. We want to do more. Please consider adding your skills to our group.
