Group Study Questions

- Think about it for a minute or two, what is the source of our worship? What makes us *desire* to worship God?
- In what ways has Oaklands' *worship* (not just music style) changed/stayed the same over the past 96 years (or for however long you've been attending)?
- What events in our immediate church history (Oaklands Chapel) and/or the worldwide church's history (past 2000 years) can we remember that lead us to worship God?
- What things do we anticipate God to do in the future? How does worship look to the future?
- Taking into account the ENTIRE biblical story (and our role in it today), how can we expand our view of worship so that it includes the past, present, and future?
- Read Acts 13: 16-30. How would this evangelistic message have evoked worship from its hearers? How does the reading and sharing of God's word among both Christians and non-Christians contribute to our worship of God?
