Persons Encountering a Personal God

- When you reflect about God (both as a group and as individuals), are you more inclined to think about who he is or what he does?
- From your reading of Exodus 3: 1-15, what specific things do you learn about God's personality? (If it helps, use Exodus 3 to inform a 'personality profile' for God—what is he like? What isn't he like?)
- In congregational life and ministry, what differences of perspective are there between regarding people as 'human resources' and viewing them as 'persons'?
- What are some practical ways that God's personality gets mentored in us? Be specific.
- How might our private devotion and congregational worship better foster human persons encountering a personal God?
