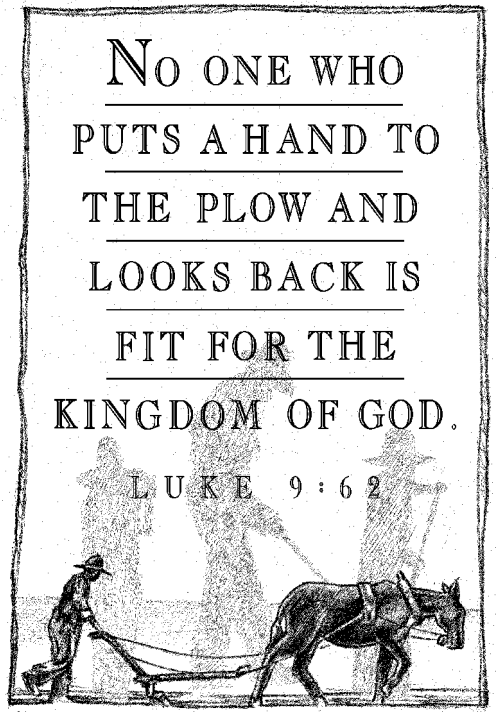
24 hour prayer focus for Monday September 14

Summer is over, now what?

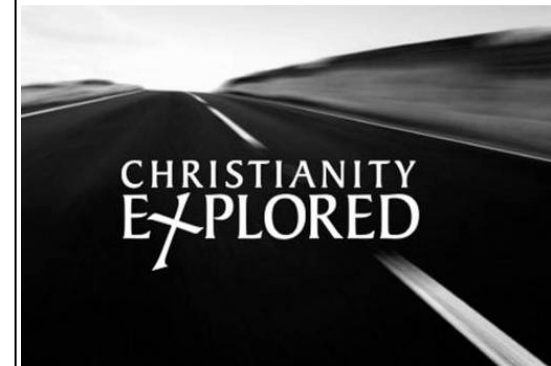
GET ACQUAINTED WITH OUR LIBRARY:
