At the Redliners Car Club we seek to present the Gospel of Jesus Christ to unchurched young men. Now entering our 23rd consecutive year, we praise God, realizing only he could have brought us this far. Our little club of a dozen boys plus half that many leaders built some crazy little vans last year, showing them proudly in the Chapel foyer on May 4th. Most of these boys are raring to return again in November for another 5 months of fun, bringing friends with them who have since been suffering from boogie van envy. This year's model will be salt flat streamliners plus the possibility of a second model that will actually race down a gravity track on show night.

But all this car stuff is pure pish-posh; just the lure to get the boys out. We have 20 sessions to move the boys from "duh, didn't we descend from monkeys?" to "God be merciful to me, a sinner." A tall order, as most of these guys are monkeys who don't realize they are sinners. We diligently present God's Word as best we can, in a creative and fun way, and pray nightly for every boy's salvation.
