

SERMON NOTES & DOODLES:

Oaklands Prayer Day July 14 – sign up for one hour (or more) in the foyer today.

Below is a focus for our prayer day.

The Father, Son and Holy Spirit have shown their deep, abiding, everlasting love for us. Think of the ways that They have loved you. Look up **Ps. 33, 91, 103, 139. John 17:26, 3:16. IPeter 2:9**, if you like, for refreshment in the Love of God.

Because of this great love, what is our response to Him? Look up some of the following: **John 5:30, 6:27,57, 14:21; IPeter 1:22, 3:8,9; Hebrews 13:15,16.**

Jesus' example on earth when He was reviled, rejected, even crucified was "Father forgive them". We on the other hand may be offended by people's treatment of us, even those very close to us.

See **Hebrews 12:15**. Do you Harbour a bitter root? Do you love your enemies as yourself? This is impossible, and undesirable in the flesh. It means we have to go very deep into God and become a "living sacrifice" in ourselves to do this. Where do you have an attitude towards others that is unloving (i.e. Not in God). Ask for a spirit of repentance. Repent for not obeying and following Jesus Christ. Ask the Lord to strengthen your spirit or strengthen you in The Spirit to be able to let His love be shed abroad in your heart, even for those who persecute and despitefully use you.
