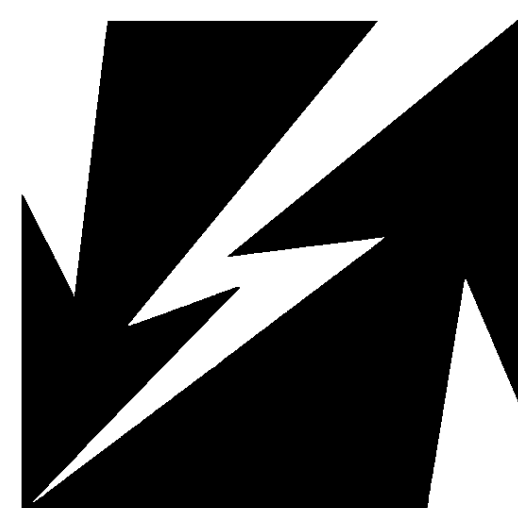
Eat with your Hands
