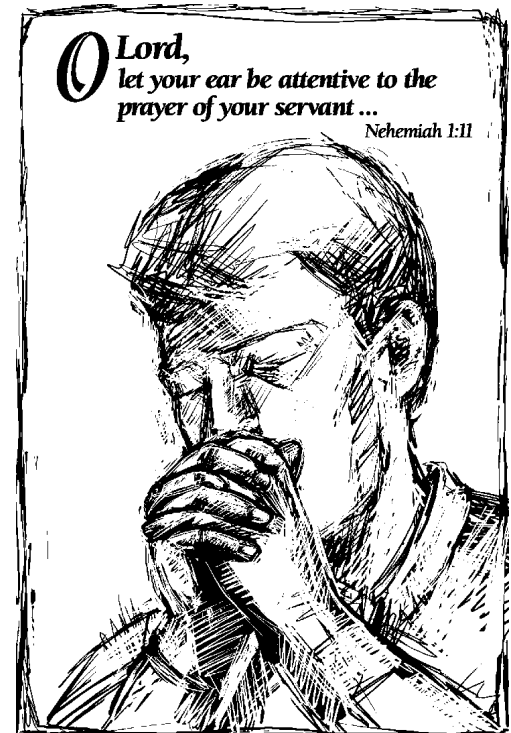
SIGN UP IN THE FOYER
