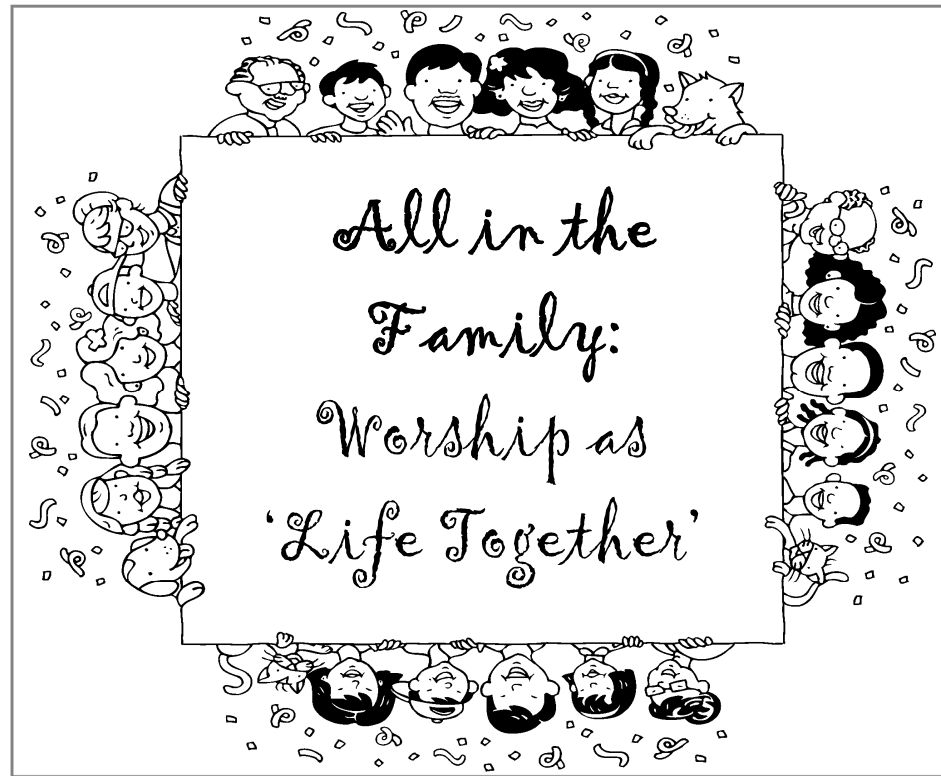



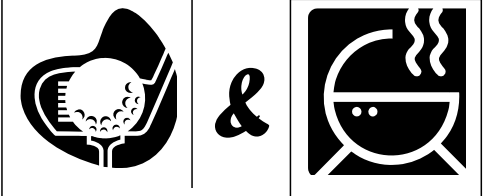


### PICNICS IN THE SUMMER: Stay tuned:
